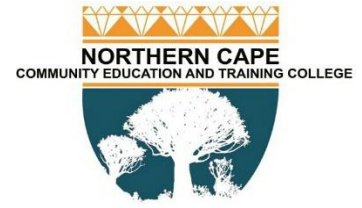

AET Level 1 to 3

Students at AET level 1 to 3 are registered for fundamental learning areas only
(They are taught how to read, write and counting)

- Communication: English / Afrikaans African Languages:-Xhosa, Setswana
- Mathematics.

AET Level 4

Students at AET level 4 (full qualification) registered for fundamental, Core and Academic or Vocational learning areas.

Fundamental learning areas

- Language (Choose one language only)
 - English
 - Setswana
 - Afrikaans(Choose one learning area between Maths literacy and Maths science)
- Mathematical literacy
- Maths Science.

Core learning areas

- Life Orientation (Its compulsory to all students).

Elective and vocational

Students may choose any two subjects from Elective or vocational.

2. Economic and Management Sciences: 21 Credits
3. One Additional Official Language (Excluding the language chosen as a Fundamental): 23 Credits

6. Small, Medium and Micro Enterprises: 17 Credits

7. Travel and Tourism: 38 Credits
