The focus is on training to become registered professionals with the respective professional bodies. Interns will be trained by Sol Plaatje Local Municipality for the duration of the contract. Candidates may apply for vacant posts as qualified professionals on completion of the training.

Minimum qualifications for Technicians: • National Diploma (GIS/relevant related qualification) • Code 08/EB driver's licence.

Key responsibilities: During the training, GIS Technician Interns will be expected to successfully demonstrate all proficiencies as determined by the respective professional bodies for the graduate development programme in the respective disciplines.

Preference will be given to applicants who permanently reside in the Frances Baard District Area or Northern Cape. The programme is restricted to South African citizens only. Appointment will also be made in the context of Employment Equity Act. The programme is strictly for unemployed graduates.
