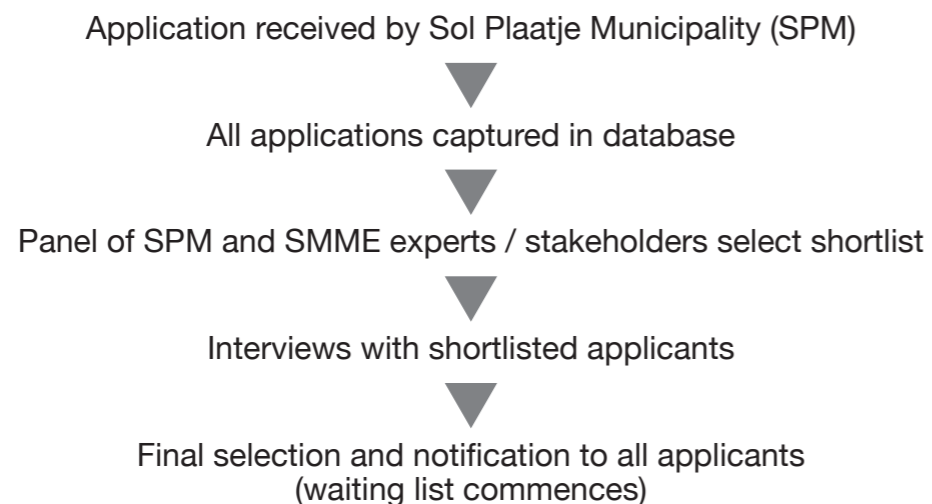

The Village will offer tenant incubation to local small business that meet the criteria, while also offering a comprehensive range of small business development services to other entrepreneurs, startups and small business owners.

These will include training, mentorship, computer skills, referral services, tender advice and shared affordable services such as bookkeeping, internet access, marketing support and office services.

It is anticipated that the centre will open in April 2012.

The SMME Village will partner with Seda, NYDA, Khula, Samaf and other small business development agencies and institutions to deliver a comprehensive set of services aimed at ensuring that as many local businesses as possible achieve profitability and sustainability.
