2. Excavation for the erection of street name shall be made according to the dimension stipulated.
3. Name Boards must be inspected by the Engineer and approved in writing before the boards are taken from the manufacturer to the site for erection
4. Street name boards must be manufactured by a recognized manufacturer of sign boards, and strictly as per the specification.
5. The contractor shall protect the completed street name boards against damage until they have been finally accepted by the employer, and he shall maintain the signs until the **maintenance certificate** has been issued. Damage or defects caused by the negligence or faulty workmanship shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost to the satisfaction of the engineer.
6. The contractor is expected to have a contract supervisory staff, and local labour will be sourced from the Platfontein community as per the Engineer and the contractors `s agreement.
7. 2.13 **“Management”** means an activity inclusive of control and performed on a daily basis, by any person who is a principal executive officer of the company, by whatever name that person may be designated, and whether or not that person is a director.

2.14 **“Owned”** means having all the customary elements of ownership, including the right of decision-making and sharing all the risks and profits commensurate with the degree of ownership interests as demonstrated by an examination of the substance, rather than the form of ownership arrangements.

**ESTABLISHMENT OF HDI EQUITY OWNERSHIP IN AN ENTERPRISE**

Equity ownership shall be equated to the percentage of an enterprise which is owned by individuals classified as HDI's, or in the case of a company, the percentage shares that are owned by individuals classified as HDI's, who are actively involved in the management and daily business operations of the enterprise and exercise control over the enterprise, commensurate with their degree of ownership.

Where individuals are not actively involved in the management and daily business operations and do not exercise control over the enterprise commensurate with their degree of ownership, equity ownership may not be claimed.
