#### **BACKGROUND**

The service provider must submit supporting documentation/proof regarding similar work that they have successfully carried out or are currently in progress within any other Municipality. #### 1.TERMS OF REFERENCE:

Sol Plaatje Municipality seeks to appoint a qualified and experienced service provider to develop a comprehensive **Tourism Master Plan** that will serve as a strategic blueprint for guiding tourism development, promotion, and investment within the municipal area. The Master Plan will aim to unlock the tourism potential of the region by identifying existing assets, untapped opportunities, infrastructure needs, market positioning, and actionable interventions that align with the broader economic development goals of the municipality

The appointed service provider or task team will be expected to undertake a structured process of research, consultation, analysis, and strategic planning. The following key deliverables will form the core components of the Tourism Master Plan project:

- **1.1. Inception Report** This report will detail the approach, methodology, and timelines of the assignment. It will include a stakeholder engagement plan that outlines how relevant tourism players, including government, private sector, communities, and civil society, will be consulted throughout the process.
- **1.2. Situational Analysis Report** A comprehensive analysis of the current tourism environment within the Sol Plaatje Municipality, identifying strengths, weaknesses, threats, and opportunities. This will include assessment of infrastructure, visitor trends, tourism services, institutional arrangements, and regulatory frameworks.
- **1.3. Tourism Asset and Opportunity Map** A visual and descriptive inventory of existing and potential tourism assets (natural, cultural, historical, and man-made) and opportunities for product development, investment, and community-based tourism.
- **1.4. Market Assessment Report** An analysis of current and potential tourism markets, including domestic and international visitor segments. This will examine demand trends, competitor destinations, target audience profiles, and growth areas.
- **1.5. Draft Tourism Master Plan** A draft version of the strategic plan outlining vision, goals, priority areas, proposed interventions, and expected outcomes for tourism development in the municipality.
- **1.6. Implementation Plan with Budget Estimates** A practical roadmap that outlines key actions, timelines, responsibilities, and indicative budgets for the implementation of the Tourism Master Plan over short-, medium-, and long-term horizons.
- **1.7. Marketing & Branding Framework** A strategy to position Sol Plaatje Municipality as a competitive and attractive tourism destination, including recommendations on destination branding, promotional activities, digital strategies, and tourism information dissemination.
- **1.8. Public Participation Process** a critical deliverable in the development of the Tourism Master Plan. It ensures that the voices of local communities, tourism stakeholders, businesses, and the general public are meaningfully included in shaping the future of tourism in the Sol Plaatje Municipality
- **1.9. Final Tourism Master Plan Document** A refined and fully developed version of the master plan, incorporating feedback from stakeholders and council briefings, and ready for adoption by the municipality.
- 2.0. Executive summarised document: prepare an executive summary of the master plan.
